**S**pandex, big hair, convertibles – the '80s bring back a flood of memories. And Brisbane's Aloha Twist Food Truck has put one of the decade's most delicious and iconic snacks into the hands of locals with its signature item, Dole Whip

A creamy pineapple ice cream created in the 1980s and one of Disneyland's most famous snacks, Dole Whip has a cult-like following across the world.

Owner Chris Forrest has almost 15 years' experience in the mobile catering industry and launched the Aloha Twist food truck earlier this year.

Chris was passionate about bringing the famous ice cream product to Queensland's shores and is excited at the interest it has generated.

"For years I have wanted to bring Dole Whip to Australia, but never took the leap," he said.

"Due to COVID-19 and not being able to travel, I missed my favourite American treat and I thought I mustn't be the only one missing it. It was a very long and expensive process, but I finally took the leap and decided to do it."

A self-confessed Dole Whip aficionado, Chris said it was the combination of delicious ice cream and Americana nostalgia that had customers lining up to snag the popular treat.



"I'm the biggest Disney fan and I have had Dole Whip at all the different Disneylands and Disney Worlds on the many travels I have had," he said.

"There is no better way to spread joy than to bring happiness to people, even if it's just a simple Dole Whip – it's amazing to see the smile it brings to people's faces after the first spoonful, as it immediately transports them back to where they first experienced it and they share their story with you."

Aloha Twist will be satisfying those with a sweet tooth at the Redcliffe Markets most Sundays, as well as selected events.

"I love that everyone comes and supports local small businesses, especially during these difficult times – without small business Australia would stop," Chris said.

"Going to events and the markets, meeting and talking to all sorts of different people is something I really love. And of course providing quality control by sampling the product!"

Keep Eco Store owner Ashleigh Hinze said all her items were Australian made, came in

sustainable packaging, used 100 per cent natural, cruelty-free ingredients and could be refilled at the in-store refilling and bulk-buy station.

"Being able to refill a bottle or container that you already have means you get to save money on the packaging and divert waste from landfill," Ashleigh said.

Keep Eco Store stocks a range of plastic and toxin-free personal products and home cleaning solutions, as well as composting and other sustainable options for households big and small.

"We also offer a fortnightly organic veggie box at wholesale prices to enable the local community access to fresh, organic and spray-free produce from local farmers doing amazing things to regenerate soils with permaculture, syntropic farming and biodynamic practices," Ashleigh said.

The leafy neighbourhood space that Keep Eco Store occupies on King Street is devoted to creativity as well as sustainability, with a variety of regular workshops advertised on social media.

"This includes everything from watercolour art classes to creative journaling, sound healing and even a monthly book club held right here in store. And, not to forget our organic veggie co-op group," Ashleigh said.

For those looking for beautiful, locally made gifts, Keep Eco Store stocks around six Peninsula artists' wares, such as Timber Dimensions, Lady Beut Wood Co, Earths Medicines, Yindi Design, Clive Street and Chloe's Heat Wheats.

"The versatility of the space has allowed me to keep things interesting and fresh for my customers and the community I have so graciously been accepted into," Ashleigh said.

"The power of belonging to a community is such a beautiful thing."

# Share Your Ideas About the Scarborough Boat Harbour

**A** community engagement process is underway as part of the State Government's master planning program for the Scarborough Boat Harbour.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) are inviting locals, visitors and boaties to have their say about the future of the harbour, either online or at one of the information sessions either held this month.

Member for Redcliffe Yvette D'Ath said the consultation would give locals the chance to guide future planning decisions.

"Community consultation plays a key role in planning projects, and we want to understand what locals want the future of Scarborough Boat Harbour to look like," Ms D'Ath said.

"This is one of Redcliffe's favourite hubs, offering boat ramps, berthing facilities, parks, playgrounds, walking trails and some of the best restaurants on the Peninsula."

Division 5 Councillor Sandra Ruck said the project was important and exciting for the Peninsula.

"Redcliffe is synonymous with the water so any opportunity we have to give more locals better access to the bay, as well as attract more visitors to our stunning region, that's something I wholeheartedly support," Sandra said.

"This isn't just for people with boats, it's about maximising the potential of sectors like hospitality, fishing, tourism and marine industries.

"I love our harbour. I think it's one of our most important amenities, so I want it to modernise

and thrive as a community precinct as our region's population grows."

Community consultation began on 9 September and will continue until Sunday, 24 October.

Feedback can be provided online or by attending a drop-in information session where residents will be able to speak to a member of the project team. This month, information sessions are being held on Tuesday, 12 October from 9am-12pm at Redcliffe Library, and on Saturday, 16 October from 9am-3pm at Dolphins Central in Kippa-Ring.

Ms D'Ath said the ideas put forward would help identify future opportunities, including improved community access.

"We want to make sure the Scarborough Boat Harbour continues to be a great asset for the community now and into the future."

TMR periodically undertakes reviews of state boat harbours, including Scarborough, to ensure they remain bustling precincts for commercial and recreational use.

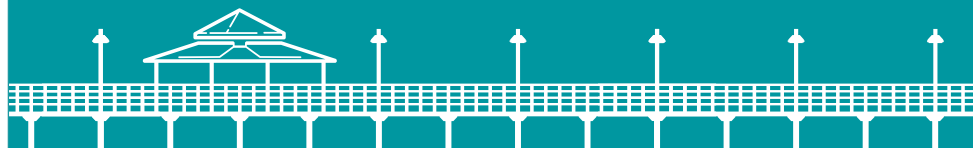

Cristina said she has always been a creative person. "Working with my hands and accomplishing detailed work came easy to me," she said. "So with my desire to give wheel throwing a go, I did just that about four years ago at the Redcliffe Pottery Club and I loved it. I was able to pick it up almost immediately and quite easily, and then became a permanent fixture at the club.

"I am now tutoring wheel throwing at the club and I can always pick out who is in it for life, or who is in it for fun. It's very obsessive!"

All the pieces on display will be available for purchase by those seeking unique gifts.

"I am so excited knowing that this year we have so many new members who have brought forward an explosion of creative inspiration," Cristina said.

"It's wonderful to see the amazing creativity that emerges from so many different personalities but all with one thing in common, a love for pottery."

**M**ore than 4,100 people participated in Moreton Bay Regional Council's community engagement survey, including many residents from the Peninsula.

Division 6 Councillor Karl Winchester said it was great to see the Peninsula score the highest survey participation in the region, representing 21 per cent of total responses.

"We have some great insights. For example, for people who live in Redcliffe, proximity to restaurants, cafes, and shops was more important than for people in Samford Valley or Dayboro," Karl said.

"Redcliffe had high satisfaction with Council's management of day-to-day services, particularly with maintenance of beaches and parks, managing waste and recycling.

"The survey also showed us that on the Peninsula, we need to do more work in town planning and protecting and preserving the environment."

The survey results highlighted three key themes – pride in the natural beauty of the region, a love of the local lifestyle, and enthusiasm for more recreation and lifestyle options.

"The survey tells us we are heading in the right direction, and puts a greater emphasis on what's important to our community," Karl said.

Moreton Bay Regional Council Mayor Peter Flannery said the feedback was released at Council's community meeting last month.

"This is an important body of work, but it's a document that will only have real meaning if we act on the expectations you've outlined for us," he said.

"Much of our focus over the past year has rightly been on responding to COVID-19, including financial support for business, rates relief for at-risk locals and massive stimulus spending on construction and community projects.

"But I think the time is right for us to now change gears and look to the longer-term, so that we can deliver on the environmental expectations and lifestyle values you've told us you want to see through Moreton Says."

Moreton Says is a series of region wide surveys Council is undertaking over the next few years. The next survey will occur later this month.

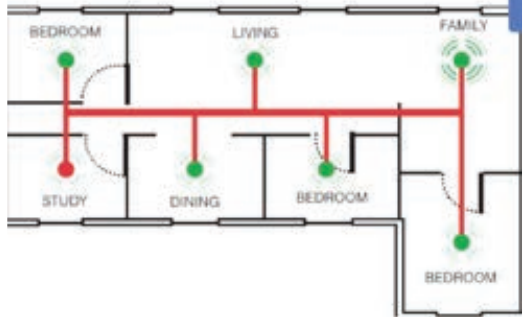

**B**etter Access to Hays Inlet Eco Path – We're replacing the existing culvert with a new, level grade and equitably accessible crossing. The upgrade will empower and enable more people to see and value the importance of our Hays

**Inlet Ramsar wetland. The project builds on the terrific path initiated by Redcliffe Environmental Forum.**



Crockatt Park Seawall has been identified for renewal.

It's vital we renew this 400m long section of our foreshore to provide protection well into the future. Funding commences in this year's budget for the four-year program, with a timeframe that includes design, procurement and delivery phases over the life of the project.

Netball on the Peninsula is set to benefit from two significant projects. Council is funding an upgrade to their amenity block with \$245,000 committed in our current budget. Court upgrades will go ahead with \$900,000 invested through the State Government courtesy of the Community Infrastructure Stimulus Program.

## YVETTE D'ATH MP

**I'm pleased to report that work is being done throughout our community thanks to the Palaszczuk government.**

The Scarborough Boat Harbour is a vibrant part of the Redcliffe Peninsula community and public consultation has commenced on the Scarborough Harbour Masterplan. There are a number of different ways for the community to be involved until consultation concludes on 24 October, 2021.



Construction is set to commence on the \$1.17 million works to the Oxley Avenue and Macdonnell Road intersection to install fully-controlled right turns, while a \$1.55 million construction project

is about to start at the Oxley Avenue and Sydney Street intersection that will see new traffic signal installation and priority access for the Redcliffe Queensland Ambulance Service.

Following on from the success of the plastic bag ban in 2018, the Palaszczuk government has now banned single-use plastic items. The ban is part of Queensland's plan to tackle plastic pollution and follows strong support from the community, retailers and industry organisations.

# Underworld Commando

Dimitri Nicholas, formerly known as Jim Taousanis.

**A** few years ago, in a quiet Scarborough street, an extremely fit, warm, friendly middle-aged man realised a lifelong ambition. He established a fitness centre, Trainers on the Bay, in which he would conduct keep-fit classes for the community.

In the process, he created an entirely new persona for himself, leaving behind more than a decade of major criminal activity - a story he has now written.

Dimitri Nicholas, or Jim Taousanis as he used to be known, featured prominently in the Channel 9 Underbelly television series, which exposed the crime and unhinged violence of Sydney's criminal underworld in the 1980s and early 90s.

Nicholas worked as 'muscle' for Sydney major crime bosses like Lenny MacPherson, George Freeman, Branco Balic and Con Kontorinakis. He rubbed shoulders with the recently deceased Arthur 'Neddy' Smith, and jailed cop Roger Rogerson. He spent time in prison and had four attempts on his life, one of which was so serious that he was placed on the dangerously ill list in hospital for weeks.

Nicholas was born in Germany to Greek parents, with the family moving to Australia in 1967. Like many migrant children, he became the butt of bullying and racial taunting at school and found that his fists were the only answer.

Self-preservation led him into boxing gyms, learning boxing and karate. Joining the State Railways Department, he started developing a promising engineering career, but the lure of greater excitement in the Army prompted a career change and he enlisted in 1986.

He joined Intelligence and achieved his ultimate ambition - becoming a member of the elite Australian Army's 1st Commando Special Services section.

But those special military skills were very attractive to Sydney's crime cartels, and by the 1980s he had been recruited with the promise of easy money and a great lifestyle.

After a decade, the clang of a prison door ended it all. His new-found respectability has prompted him to write his revealing life story. His book *Underworld Commando* is available from Trainers on the Bay or you can purchase online at [www.jimtaousanis.com.au](http://www.jimtaousanis.com.au).

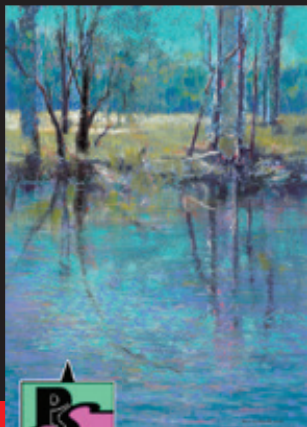

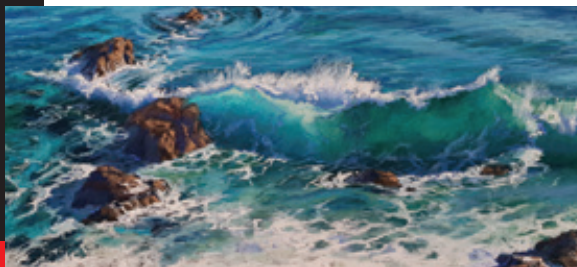

## FISH OF THE MONTH

### Bull Shark

Sam Kelly - Bull Shark

## Carcharhinus leucas

**T**his species has widespread distribution in tropical and warm temperate waters worldwide, and is found in all Australian states except South Australia, Victoria and Tasmania.

Being one of the more aggressive sharks, one of the very few “dangerous to people” and very common in our local area, I am surprised we don’t hear about more attacks.

Bull Sharks mature at 9-10 years and can live 20-30 years. They grow to about 3.5 metres. Because they can live in freshwater, they can venture all the way up into the freshwater reaches of our rivers. Some are even found over 4000 kilometres from the sea in the Amazon River.

With an omnivorous diet which includes fish (including other sharks), dolphins, eels, turtles, birds, molluscs, and even terrestrial mammals including pigs, cattle, dogs and rats, they are quite easy to catch. Chunks of eel and stingray are the preferred baits with local fishermen.

I’m not a big fan of eating sharks but quite a few people think the smaller Bull Sharks taste quite good.

# Clontarf's New Legal Support Service for Veterans

**D**uty First Legal co-founders Sarah and Aaron Smith have put their passion for helping the veteran community into practice by forming a law firm dedicated to all service men, service women, their spouses, and their widows.

Duty First Legal has just opened at Clontarf and strives to provide legal advice and services to veterans who find themselves needing assistance after leaving the forces.

Co-owner and solicitor Sarah Smith said her husband Aaron is a veteran, and they had experienced first-hand the difficulties this community endured when trying to adapt to life outside of the defence force.

"There is no other service like this. After leaving the army, navy or air force, a lot of the veterans struggle with family issues, parenting issues and divorce. Some get in trouble with the law, struggle with employment, and have housing issues," Sarah said.

"We will try and help them with any problems and if we can't help them, we will refer them to other agencies, and we will guide them to where they need to go."

According to DVA statistics, Moreton Bay Local Government Area has one of the country's highest populations of veterans.

To help support them, Duty First needs the support of the veteran community to create a sustainable service, as they receive no funding.

"We are independent to DVA and the government because we know many veterans may be having difficulty with these departments," Sarah said. "They don't have to be registered with DVA to receive our no- or low-cost help. We are by veterans for veterans"

Sarah and Aaron have big goals for Duty First Legal, and are hoping they can eventually take the service Australia-wide and help as many veterans as possible.

"It makes us feel quite proud. It's about helping the community that has sacrificed so much for us. A lot of them are quite young and you think that they're fine," Sarah said.

"But when you know what's underneath and what they're going through, it's really meaningful to be able to help them and know that you're actually making a really practical difference in their life."

## 5. The Haunting of Hill House

For a series based on a novel written in 1959, this retelling of the classic haunted house tale feels fresh. The story unravels in a non-linear way, leaving you to connect the dots between a troubled family's past and present, with plenty of unnerving moments and scares while you try to piece the puzzle together.

## 4. Black Summer

If you're after something a bit less subtle, Black Summer should get your heart pumping. Set in a world where zombies are everywhere and also bloody fast, we follow a group of strangers as they try to make it to safety. Unlike the TV series it's based on 'Z Nation' (also streaming on Netflix), it's actually really good. Completists may want to give the second season a go but I found it lacked the storytelling of the first.

## 3. Black Mirror

Some of the episodes in this collection of often futuristic stories are chilling, some are confronting, but all of them will make you

take a long, hard look at yourself. With five seasons to binge on, this collection of mostly self-contained mini movies features a technological element that changes someone's life, often with terrifying consequences. You never know where you'll be with each episode, and even though it was made 10 years ago, it's still as relevant as ever, maybe even more so.

## 2. Hannibal

This isn't your typical spin-off series. Based on the early years of everyone's favourite psycho psychiatrist, Hannibal Lecter, this story expands on the universe Thomas Harris' novels created, while staying true to the source material. New crimes, new characters and new victims are all on the menu. It's beautifully directed, featuring superb writing and talented performances from the entire cast, with Hugh Dancy and Mads Mikkelsen acting their chops off. Its glacial pace may be too slow for some, but true connoisseurs will lap it up and ask for seconds.

## 1. Stranger Things

It's 1983, and when a group of friends on the hunt for a missing mate find a lost girl, they uncover something bigger and scarier than they could have imagined. Even if you've already watched this series back at the peak of its hype in 2016, I think enough time has passed to give it a rewatch and scratch that nostalgia itch.

"The aim of *Recipes on Paper* is to encourage the community to engage more with the older generation and to pinch those delicious, foolproof recipes they have been cooking for decades," she said.

"I originally wanted to start with a series of short videos, then the pandemic hit and it became hard to visit potential Goldies. That's when I thought of starting an online gallery of stories, interviews and recipes."

Julia said she was inspired by the close relationship she had with her own grandmothers.

"I would especially watch my maternal grandmother cook in the kitchen," she said. "I would go to her house in the afternoon and if I

had a bad day at school, she would whip me up something and it just made everything better."

*Recipes on Paper* profiles one new Goldie each week, and focuses on recipes from the region. The online gallery showcases Julia's photos of produce sourced from the Redcliffe Seaside Markets and local stores.

"This food blog will modernise and bring to life the diverse meals that are cooked in our wonderful community here on the Redcliffe Peninsula," Julia said.

If you are or know a Goldie and would like to share a recipe, Julia would love to hear from you.

"Whether it be a sauce, jam, or even a great sandwich combo, the aim is to showcase all types of food from different cultures," she said.

"I already have 12 recipes lined up so it's very exciting that people have had such a positive response to it."

One day, Julia hopes to see the Goldies and their recipes turned into a published book.

"That is the goal," she said. "It's called *Recipes on Paper* after all."

**T**his dish is incredibly quick and is perfect for a weeknight meal. It's minimal effort with maximum flavour and is one of those dishes when you want a hit of veggies but don't want to compromise on flavour. It's also perfect as a side dish to complement a seafood lunch or an easy accompaniment for a Sunday roast.



I have used house-made chorizo from Gilly's Smallgoods in Clontarf.

Redcliffe's very own boutique Butcher.

These guys know their meats and have been in this business since 1983. The spices of the sausage pairs perfectly with the nuttiness of the broccolini. You could use almost any woody vegetable for this dish, but I have chosen broccolini which I picked up from the Redcliffe Markets. Needless to say they are the freshest around.



### Warm Broccolini and Chorizo Salad with Pine Nuts.

**3 bunches broccolini**  
**2 chorizo**  
**¼ cup pine nuts**  
**1 teaspoon chilli flakes**  
**garlic oil**  
**lemon wedges to serve**

Cut chorizo lengthways and then cut into 1cm half-moon shapes. Add to a hot pan and cook until sizzling and golden brown. Remove and allow to drain on paper towel. You can remove some of the excess oil in the pan but make sure to leave a little to fry the broccolini – you want that smoky flavour!

Cut broccolini stems into 2cm pieces leaving the florets a little longer. Allow pan to get



hot again (the magic happens when the pan is hot!) and add the broccolini allowing each side to brown before tossing. You want a bit of charr to bring out that nutty flavour.

Once these have started to turn a vibrant green colour, add the chorizo back in the pan and drizzle with garlic-infused olive oil. Toss together and transfer to a plate.

To serve, sprinkle with pine nuts (you could also use slivered almonds or walnuts), a good squeeze of lemon juice and if you like a bit of heat, sprinkle with chilli flakes.

*Note: Kidney beans are also good in this dish and if you want a bit of crunch, you could add some croutons.*

**S**carborough teen Ashton Edwards has been awarded an aviation scholarship to help him gain his recreational pilot's license. Ashton wants to fly solo at age 15, and with his birthday creeping closer in February, his dream is only a stone's throw away.

Ashton has spent many of his 14 years dreaming of becoming a pilot. He passed many hours practising on his PC flight simulator. At age 12, he had his first flight lesson.

The aspiring pilot has pursued his goal by changing schools from Southern Cross Catholic College to Aviation State High School, while taking on shifts at Hungry Jack's Kippa-Ring to help his parents pay for the costly flight lessons.

Ashton said it felt wonderful knowing he was contributing to his future and his personal passion.

"When I'm up in the air I feel great and it removes all my worries," he said. "I'm not stressed when I'm up there knowing I am working towards what I want to achieve."

"It has been stressful changing schools, getting a job, doing flying and sports – but it's all worth it."

Through his flight instructor, Ashton found out about an Aviation Australia Flying Scholarship that could help pay for his flight hours and get him on his way to soaring the skies solo.

Of the 76 candidates that applied nationally in the under-25 category, Ashton was one of 10 who won a scholarship, thanks to his commitment, maturity and prior flight experience.

He said the process involved collecting references from his flight instructors and teachers to prove that he wanted to be awarded the scholarship because of his serious career aspirations, and not just for fun.

All of Ashton's references were impressive, and highlighted his level of dedication and maturity, with his flight instructor leaving glowing remarks about his advanced flight skills for someone so young.

"Receiving this scholarship creates a lot of opportunities for me," Ashton said. "I would like to work for Qantas as a pilot, and having this extra flight experience and being at Aviation High will hopefully get me in the door to such an iconic company."

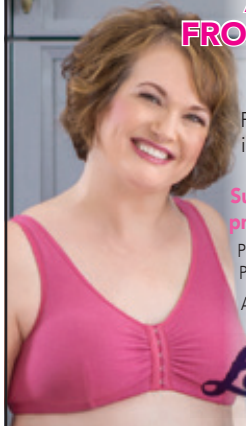

**R**edcliffe Hospital has been caring for the community since the 1960s and now the community has the opportunity to give back.

Raise it for Redcliffe is holding the inaugural Redcliffe Hospital Giving Day on Wednesday, 13 October to raise money for life-changing initiatives and projects.

Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital (RBWH) Foundation CEO Simone Garske said that Redcliffe Hospital and RBWH partnered earlier this year through Raise it for Redcliffe to foster a culture of engagement and philanthropy in the community.

Every dollar donated before 13 October will be doubled thanks to the support of local businesses including BallyCara, GKS Law, The Komo and The Belvedere.

Simone said the community could register online to organise their own fundraising events.

"Local businesses and community groups have really taken fundraising on board," she said. "Domino's recently announced a Giving Day Doughraiser. Six Moreton Bay stores will donate \$1 from every pizza sold on October 13. Bridge FM are our broadcast partner and will host a radiothon on the big day.

"One of our most creative fundraisers is Redcliffe Hospital's own Director of Research and Medical Education, Dr Joel Dulhunty. Dr Joel is riding 500 kilometres around Redcliffe on his penny farthing bicycle to raise \$10,000. Now that's got to be worth donating to!"

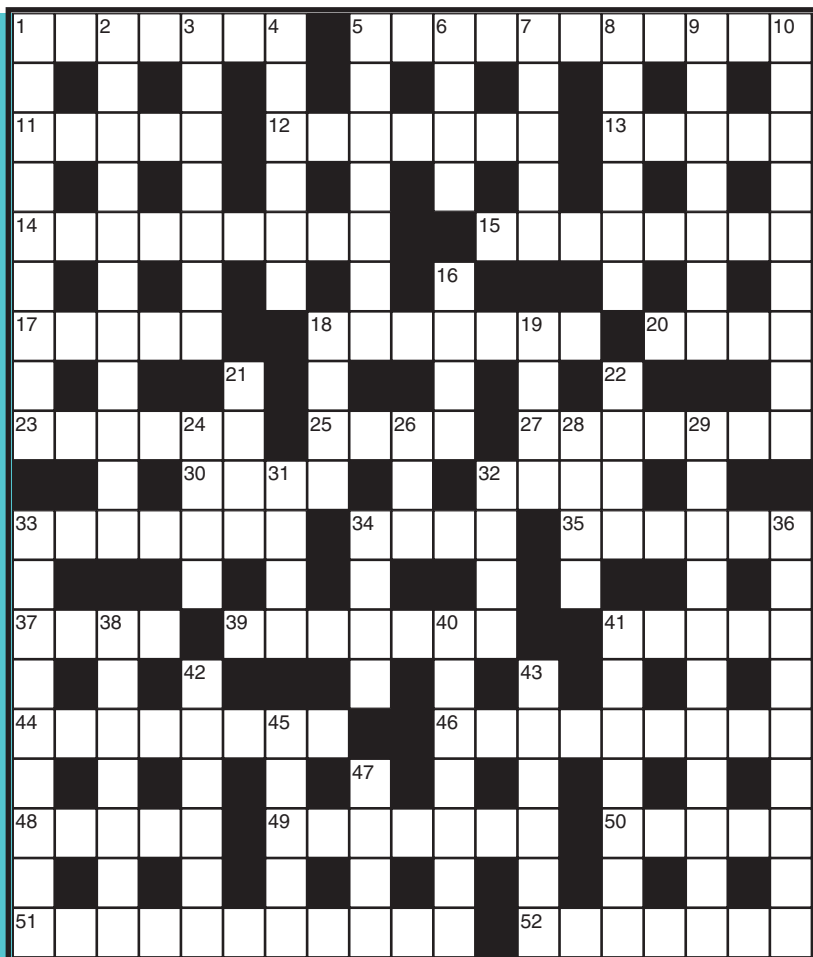

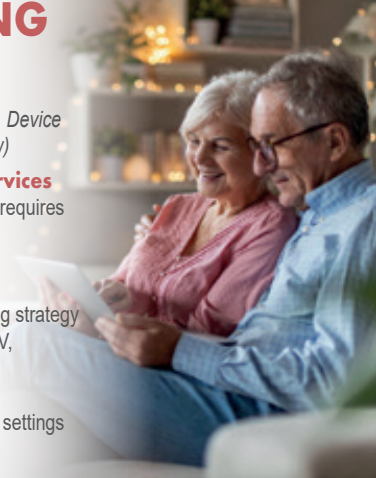
